## NEW RESTROOMS NOW FUNCTIONING

After an amazingly non-intrusive construction period over the summer, the new restrooms in the undercroft and the parish house basement are available for use. This will eliminate the long lines during intermission at Trinity Center concerts and eliminate the recurrent plumbing disasters in Wintershelter.

The work was done using the Trinity Center Capital Campaign funds. Campaign Chair Nancy Gatschet and TCUL President Phyllis Schnell worked tremendously hard at raising the money from individuals and foundations, along with a committee of volunteer fundraisers.

Some pledges to the Capital Campaign are still outstanding. If yours is one of them, please complete your pledge; the money is badly needed.

### The next step

Next on the agenda is making the buildings accessible. Our good friend Representative Babette Josephs was responsible for a state grant to TCUL for a wheelchair lift. We are still raising money to "close the gap" in funding so we can proceed with the handicapped accessibility project. We received a major grant this summer from the Connelly Foundation for this project, but we still have a way to go. If you never contributed to the original fund drive or would like to contribute more to create full accessibility to Trinity Center, you can mail a check made out to the TCUL Capital Campaign to Trinity Center, 2212 Spruce Street, Philadelphia PA 19103. We hope to be able to complete Phase II in 2007.
